

# MISSION TRIP INFORMATION

Cost: \$150 per student (payment Due by July 1<sup>st</sup>)

Date: July 12<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>

Location: Florida United Methodist Children's Home

(51 Main St, Deltona, FL 32725)

**Who:** All Students 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade

**Work:** All students will be expected to work every day. The main purpose of this trip is to work at the children's home. We will be working on the campus and the thrift store for the children's home. It will be hot and lots of manual labor!

**Dress:** The Children's Home has a dress code, which all mission team members must follow while on campus. Dress code: shorts that come halfway down the thigh, No halter or spaghetti straps, and no mid drift is to be showing. Closed toe shoes worn while working.

**When:** We leave Monday Morning @ 9:30 am (July 12<sup>th</sup>) eat breakfast before. Returning Saturday @ 4pm (July 17<sup>th</sup>)

**Typical Day:** 8am wake up, 8:30 eat breakfast, 9am go out to work, 12noon eat lunch, 1pm go back to work, 4pm shower and start dinner, 5:30 eat dinner. 7pm devotion time, 8pm Nerf Wars/Group games, 11pm lights out.

## What to Bring List

- ☐ 2 Sheets and a blanket, OR sleeping bag (Bunk Beds)

- ☐ Work clothes: Girl's Capris or fingertip length shorts. No spaghetti strap shirts. Guy's gym shorts. Tennis Shoes (to work in; **you cannot work in flip flops**)
- ☐ Spending Money (for Wal-Mart and trip \$25)
- ☐ Reusable water bottle
- ☐ Hat for sun, Insect repellent, Sunscreen, Laundry detergent. (we have access to washer and dryer)
- ☐ Bath towels & washcloth Toiletries: shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste, deodorant, soap, hairbrush and/or comb
- ☐ Work Clothes for 4 days (clothes that will get sweaty, and dirty) shirts, shorts, underwear (bra for girls), socks, raincoat, and lightweight jacket or sweater.
